- Attention all students: As the weather begins to warm up, please be advised that dress code will be strictly enforced. Please refer to the student conduct code handbook or the dress code policy posted in the attendance office.

- <u>Prom Ticket Sales:</u> Do not wait until the last minute to buy your prom tickets. PROM TICKET SALES WILL END AT 3:30 P.M. ON FRIDAY (even if there is still a line). If you have not purchased your tickets by that time, you will have to buy the tickets at the door on Saturday for the increased price of \$45 per ticket. Prom tickets can be purchased in the Finance Office before school, at lunch and after school. Tickets are also being sold out of Room 601 (Student Store) Thursday during lunch and after school, and Friday during lunch only.
- Attention all students: Please have all items removed from your locker on or before the last day of school Friday, June 2nd. Any items left behind WILL BE DISCARDED. Locker rooms will be closed over the summer for maintenance.

Prices are \$25 single ticket with ASB; \$35 single ticket w/o ASB; \$45 single ticket at the door. If your date to the PROM is not currently a Junior or Senior you must have an approved guest pass for them to purchase a ticket. Also, if your date is not a VUSD student you must have an approved guest pass in order for your guest to attend the dance. Guest passes may be picked up in the Student Services Office and must be turned back in to Mrs. Naylor by Wednesday, May 10 by 4:00 pm in order to get it approved. Remember that you must be clear of all fines in order to be eligible to purchase a ticket.
