### **Loitering Policy**

#### Specific areas where student loitering is prohibited:

- 1. Parking lots, Restrooms (Students are not allowed to go to their vehicle and retrieve items during class time)
- 2. Playing fields outside the gated area (unless under adult supervision)
- 3. Bicycle/skateboard racks
- 4. Front of the school on Whitendale Avenue
- 5. Bus drop off lane on Crenshaw Street
- 6. On school grounds after school hours unless in a supervised activity or classroom
