<input type="checkbox"/>	YOUR 2016 Federal Income Tax Return Forms <b>and</b> W-2's, or last check stub you received in 2016. If you had more than one job then bring the last check stub received for each job ( <i>only if you worked</i> )
<input type="checkbox"/>	PARENT(s) 2016 Federal Income Tax Return Forms <b>and</b> W-2's, or last check stub they received in 2016. If they had more than one job then bring the last check stub received for each job

<input type="checkbox"/>	PARENT(s): 2016 bank statements and investments records ( <i>only if they have</i> )
