- Your Social Security Card & Driver's License or State ID or Permanent Resident Card (If you are not a US Citizen)
- Your and your parent(s)' 2016 Federal Income Tax Return & W-2 Forms (if available)
- Your and your parent(s)' 2016 bank statements and investment records.
- Any records of untaxed income received in 2015 such as Social Security benefits, child support received, TANF benefits, payments to IRAs or 401K's or military or clergy allowances.
- List of colleges you have applied to or are interested in attending.
- Bring FAFSA pin number if you have it.
