Remember that <u>you must be clear of all fines</u> in order to be eligible to attend. In addition, you must present a current valid school I.D. at the door to be admitted to the dance! No exceptions! Appropriate dancing and behavior is expected! <u>Dress Code</u> will be strictly enforced.
