- <u>COS Placement Test</u>—Seniors: The COS Placement Test will be taking place here on campus on\_February 21st & 23rd. Please see Ms. Reynolds in the student services office to sign up.
  Last chances to take this placement test on our campus this school year!
- <u>Seniors: Grad Nite</u> is Thursday, May 4th. The cost for Grad Nite is \$175, CASH ONLY; tickets will go on sale at 7:30 a.m. on Monday, 2/26/18 this is the ONLY day you can purchase tickets. You will need to line up to purchase your tickets with the people you want to be on the same bus with. There will be NO BUS CHANGES after you purchase your

ticket. Students are not permitted on campus until 7:00 a.m. – "camping out" is not allowed. In order to purchase your tickets to Grad Nite, you MUST be on track to graduate and make sure to clear all fines through the Finance office and the Library. You will not be admitted to purchase tickets for Grad Nite without a completed Grad Nite Permission packet which includes your parent signatures and signatures from the library and finance office. **PARENT NOTES** 

- Attention Parents of Advanced Placement (AP) Students: All AP exams will be available for purchase beginning December 1, 2017. The cost of <u>each</u> AP exam offered through college-board is \$94. You may purchase the exams either in the Finance Office on campus OR on the EDHS web-store online. All test purchases must be made no later than February 15, 2018. No deposit is required, but exams must be paid in full by February 15<sup>th</sup> for El Diamante to order your exam from College Board. If your student is taking multiple exams you can purchase one exam at a time to help break up the payments. (If your student currently qualifies for free OR reduced lunch they can inquire about a reduced test price in the Student Services Office). Any student who does not purchase their exams IN <u>FULL</u> by February 15<sup>th</sup> will not have an exam ordered due to ordering deadlines and procedures implemented by the Collegeboard.
