Visalia Breakfast Rotary Club Scholarship

The Visalia Breakfast Rotary Club ("VBR") awards the Vocational Scholarship to local high school graduates who are pursuing qualified studies in an eligible program in the technical and vocational fields. The definition of an "eligible program" is that contained in Federal Career and Technical Education legislation, which is a two-year or less career or technical program culminating in an associate degree, diploma or certificate, but less than a Bachelor's Degree. Persons enrolling in a four-year course leading to Bachelor's Degree are not eligible to apply. The Vocational Scholarship consists of \$1,000 awarded per school year (\$500 for the fall semester and \$500 for the spring semester) for a maximum of two (2) school years. Scholarship applications are submitted to the Visalia Breakfast Rotary Club Scholarship Committee for their consideration, review, and selection of the recipient.

Criteria:

- This scholarship may be awarded to an applicant who is a Tulare County high school graduate attending an accredited institution within Tulare County.
- Applicants must be enrolled in their first semester at an accredited postsecondary institution and submit proof of enrollment to receive the scholarship funds.
- Applicants must be enrolled in at least one vocational class for their eligible program at an accredited institution. If at any time during the funding cycle the applicant does not successfully complete the vocational program, the scholarship shall be forfeited.
- The offer of a scholarship is valid only during the academic period for which the offer is made.

Deadline: Applications must be submitted no later than 12:00 p.m. on the due date.
