- Commencement Practice: starts at 8am on Friday, June 1. Plan in advance to arrive earlier to ensure you find parking at the Mineral King Bowl. Students not at the practice will not be allowed to participate in the event. Don't be late!
- Commencement Ceremony: Students need to check in and arrive to the RHS gym at 6pm. Leave all items in your car or with your family. If you arrive with items, you will be asked to return to your cars to put away your belongings.
