

## Congressman Devin Nunes Academy Nomination Process

To be considered for an appointment to a service academy, an applicant must have a nomination from an authorized nominating source. Title 10, U.S. Code Annotated establishes two nomination categories. The first, usually referred to as "congressional nominations," includes the nominations of the Vice President and Members of the United States House of Representatives and Senate. The second, referred to as "service connected" or "military-affiliated" nominations, includes the selections of the President and nominations of the appropriate service. Appointment to an academy includes a four-year scholarship with a service obligation.

Each academy's freshman class convenes in late June/early July. Therefore, high school students will be submitting their applications during the fall of their senior year and will enter the academy right after high school graduation. Students will be notified of their acceptance by April of the year they enter the academy.

#### **Congressman Nunes' Nomination Application Process**

- 1. Contact Congressman Devin Nunes' office and complete the "Intent to Seek Nomination Form." This will allow Congressman Nunes' office to keep you advised of upcoming events and deadlines.
- 2. Contact your academies of choice as soon as possible and begin the academy application process. Once your file is opened, the academies will begin to make an evaluation taking into consideration: Character, Leadership, Physical Aptitude, Medical Fitness and Motivation. Listed below are the four service academies that require a nomination.

- 3. Complete Congressman Nunes' "Academy Nomination Application." You are required to include with the application copies of high school transcripts, a brief essay, list of extracurricular activities, letters of reference, a photo, and SAT/ACT score verification. The completed packet is due to Congressman Nunes' Visalia Office by November 15<sup>th</sup>. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- 4. If qualified, an interview will be scheduled in December with Congressman Nunes' Academy Selection Committee. This committee is composed of military, academic, and community leaders.
- 5. Students will be notified as to whether or not a nomination will be given by January 31<sup>st</sup> of the entering class year.

#### General Nomination Admission Standards and Eligibility

The following eligibility requirements must be met by each applicant as of July 1 of the year of admission to the service academy.

Age Must be between the ages of 17 and 23 years old

Citizenship Must be a United States citizen

Marital Status Unmarried, not pregnant and have no legal obligation to support children or

other dependents

A candidate's competitive standing is determined by his or her high school academic records, rank in class, SAT-I or ACT standardized test scores, recommendations, leadership development potential, interest in the maritime industry and the potential to develop into a competent officer. Required tests must be taken within 18 months of the application deadline. Candidates must also pass a medical exam set forth by the Department of Defense Medical Examination Review Board.

Please note: A congressional nomination is not a guarantee of admission. The final decision to appoint will be made by the academy itself following the final review of your medical and academic qualifications by the Academy Admissions Board. The majority of appointments will be offered by the academies by April of the entering class year.
