mailed out the week of June 17, 2019 after grades have posted.

- <u>The Senior Reflections Assembly</u> is on Friday, May 17. All seniors are required to still attend 2nd period class in order to attend their Grad Nite trip to Universal Studios. All students grades 9-12 will attend the Reflections Assembly. <u>Seniors will meet with their homeroom teacher on the blacktop</u> (basketball courts/west side of the gym) to walk into the assembly together. We will not have homeroom on May 17.
