The clubs listed below are not the only clubs on campus; we encourage students to create their own if they feel there is a need. Anyone interested in joining a club should see a club officer or the club advisor. - **Ablaze Catholic Club – Ms. Jacobsma – Room #357** – To continue student’s Catholic education through connecting faith to school life, demonstrate Catholic teachings through service to the school and community, and foster a Catholic community through fellowship.
