 <u>College Application Deadlines & Help:</u> Below are some of the most common application deadlines for this fall college application season. *Mr. Stahl will be available for college application help from Oct 2 Nov 22 every WED and FRI in computer lab 61 during homeroom.* Come by the Student Services Office and sign up to receive a Homeroom Pass to attend. **REMINDER THAT ALL CSU/UC**

APPLICATIONS ARE DUE ON NOVEMBER 30TH. The last day to get help from Mr. Stahl is <u>NOVEMBER 22</u>, before we go on break.

- Seniors: <u>Grad Nite</u> is Friday, May 15th, 2020. The destination will be Disneyland and CA Adventure
 Park. The cost for Grad Nite is \$245, CASH ONLY; tickets will go on sale at 7:30 a.m. on Monday, March
 9th, 2020 this is the ONLY day you can purchase tickets. <u>The ticket is non-refundable!</u> You will need to
 line up to purchase your tickets with the people you want to be on the same bus with. There will be
 <u>NO BUS CHANGES</u> after you purchase your ticket. Students are not permitted on campus until 7:00
 a.m. "camping out" is not allowed. In order to purchase your tickets to Grad Nite, you <u>MUST be on
 track to graduate, be on track with a 94% attendance rate</u> the week prior to Grad Nite <u>and</u> make sure
 to clear all fines through the Finance office and the Library. You will not be admitted to purchase
 tickets for Grad Nite without a completed Grad Nite Permission packet which includes your parent
