Every senior and their parent must have one in order to submit their FAFSA or Dream Act Application.

The destination will be **Disneyland and CA Adventure Park.** The cost for Grad Nite is **\$245**, CASH ONLY; tickets will go on sale at 7:30 a.m. on **Monday**, **March 9<sup>th</sup>**, **2020** this is the ONLY day you can purchase tickets. <u>The ticket is non-refundable!</u> You will need to line up to purchase your tickets with the people you want to be on the same bus with. There will be **NO BUS CHANGES** after you purchase your ticket. Students are not permitted on campus until 7:00 a.m. "camping out" is not allowed. In order to purchase your tickets to Grad Nite, you <u>MUST be on</u> **track to graduate, be on track with a 94% attendance rate** the week prior to Grad Nite <u>and</u> make sure to clear all fines through the Finance office and the Library. You will not be admitted to purchase tickets for Grad Nite without a completed Grad Nite Permission packet which includes your parent signatures and signatures from the library and finance office. <u>NO EXCEPTIONS</u>.
