  to graduate, be on track with a 94% attendance rate</u> the week prior to Grad Nite <u>and</u> make sure to
  clear all fines through the Finance office and the Library. You will not be admitted to purchase tickets
  for Grad Nite without a completed Grad Nite Permission packet which includes your parent signatures
