- <u>Attention Parents of Advanced Placement (AP) Students</u>: All AP exams are now available for purchase. The cost of each AP exam offered through college-board is \$96. You may purchase the exams either in the finance office on campus OR on the EDHS web-store online. All test purchases must be made no later than Friday, October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2021. No deposit is required, but exams must be paid in full for El Diamante to order your exam from CollegeBoard. (If your student currently qualifies for free OR reduced lunch they can inquire about a reduced test price with Ms. Reynolds in the Student Services Office). Any student who does not purchase their exams IN FULL by October 15th will not have an exam ordered due to ordering deadlines and procedures implemented by the CollegeBoard. VUSD Fee Waiver: there is a one-time fee waiver provided by VUSD for one exam during the 4 years of high school. If your student chooses to use this for an exam this year they will need to submit the VUSD One Time Waiver Form. Contact Mrs. Garcia with any questions regarding AP exams.
