THE YOUNG LEADERS ACADEMY PROGRAM

The Young Leaders Academy is a four-week long program open to high school students between the ages of 14-18. The goal of this program is to provide students an opportunity to develop their skills in leadership, team-building, problem solving and to understand the role of county government and civic engagement. This program will help students understand the issues and challenges in the Central Valley, while learning about the daily functions of local government. Students will understand the importance of their involvement in community. We anticipate a total of 15 student participants for the first cohort this summer.

Participants will receive a certificate of completion that can be used for college applications and/or added to their resumes.

The Young Leaders Academy is free of charge. The program will run from July 8 to July 31, 2019.
