The University of Redlands is a private, nonprofit, Southern California university offering more than 70 programs in the arts, humanities, sciences, education and business programs. Redlands also has, 21 Division III athletic teams, more than 120,000 annual community service hours, and over 100 club offerings. Soka University is a private, non-profit, four-year liberal arts college that offers four different concentrations in Environmental Studies, Humanities, Social Behavioral Science and International studies.
