STUDENT INFORMATION

- Gdub Car Club will not meet today, Thursday September 26. We will instead meet Thursday, October 3 at lunch.
- Javi's Delivery: Javi's delivery will now be available for pick up by the Blazer Marquee in the parking lot on McAuliff. Freshman will no longer be allowed to leave campus to pick up lunch from Javi's, you will have to have an ID and be in 10th, 11th or 12th grade.
- Moonlight Harvest Dance: Will be held on Saturday, October 5 from 8 – 11 p.m. in the Mt. Whitney High School Gym. Tickets go on sale beginning Monday, September 30-Thursday, October 3 in the Finance Office before school, during lunch or after school for \$15 per single ticket w/ASB, \$25 per single ticket w/o ASB, \$45 per single ticket at the door. If your date to the dance is NOT a VUSD student you must have an approved guest pass in order for your guest to attend the dance. Guest passes for students outside of VUSD may be picked up in the Main Office and must be turned back in to Mrs. Maravilla no later than Wednesday, October 2 by 3:30 pm in order to get it approved (NO LATE GUEST PASSES WILL BE APPROVED!). Remember that you must be clear of all fines in order to be eligible. In addition, you must present a current valid school I.D. at the door to be admitted to the dance! No exceptions! Appropriate dancing and behavior is expected! Dress Code will be strictly enforced. Please see attached dress code. The time for pictures will be 6-7 pm and then starting again at 8 pm in the MWHS Gymnasium. **THERE WILL BE NO AFTER SCHOOL SALES ON FRIDAY, only before school and lunch.**

COUNSELOR INFORMATION

- ***AP students and parents:** AP Tests are now on sale!! Please refer to the AP documents for information regarding the fees, dates, and deadlines for 2019/2020 AP exams. <https://www.vusd.org/Page/12318> Tests can be purchased at the GW Finance Office and we also accept payments via credit card online at the GW webstore! https://webstores.activenetwork.com/school-software/golden_west_high_sch/

November 5, 2019 is the absolute last day to pay for AP Exams!

NEW THIS YEAR: YOU MUST REGISTER FOR EACH AP EXAM THROUGH YOUR COLLEGE BOARD ACCOUNT. You may only purchase AP exams between September 18, 2019 and November 5, 2019. STUDENTS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR \$40 UNUSED/CANCEL EXAM FEE if they do not show up on test day!

Be sure to check and see if your student qualifies for a fee waiver, and if so, the directions for obtaining a fee waiver. The fee waiver paperwork can be completed immediately and turned in to Mrs. McIntosh in the office. For any questions contact Mrs. Gajdusek in the counseling office.

- **PSAT** – The PSAT is a practice test for the SAT. Students who are planning on going directly to a 4-year university after high school should take this practice exam. It is available for juniors, sophomores, and freshmen. The actual exam will be administered on Wednesday, Oct. 16 from 7:45 am – 12pm. The cost of the exam is \$17. Mrs. Hunter will start taking payments to sign up for the exam on **Monday, September 23 before school, during lunch, and after school at the finance window.** Checks should be made out to Golden West High School. The tests will be sold on a first come, first serve basis and we only have a limited number of exams. Last year we sold out in 3 days so please come early if you want to take the PSAT. **Fee waivers are available for JUNIORS only.** Juniors who qualify for the fee waiver and can take the test for FREE. Please see Mrs. Shaewitz in the counseling office for a fee waiver starting Monday, September 23th before school, during lunch, or after school. If you have any questions regarding the PSAT, please see Mrs. Shaewitz.
- **The ASVAB test sign ups are CLOSED.** The maximum we can test is 65. Students will be admitted in order of sign up. A waitlist has been set up. A reminder pass will be sent out the day before the test. Waitlisted students will be invited to test as space allows. We generally have a 15% attendance drop out rate so it is VERY POSSIBLE you will be allowed to test if you are present. We will be having another ASVAB test in March.
