Eligible applicants must be high school seniors or high school graduates who are currently enrolled or accepted for enrollment in any accredited U.S. institution of higher Learning. November 5, 2019 is the absolute last day to pay for AP Exams! **NEW THIS YEAR:** YOU MUST REGISTER FOR EACH AP EXAM THROUGH YOUR COLLEGE BOARD ACCOUNT. You may only purchase AP exams between September 18, 2019 and November 5, 2019. STUDENTS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR \$40 UNUSED/ CANCEL EXAM FEE if they do not show up on test day! **Be sure to check and see if your student qualifies for a fee waiver, and if so, the directions for obtaining a fee waiver.** The fee waiver paperwork can be completed immediately and turned in to Mrs. McIntosh in the office.
