ANNUAL LIONS STUDENT SPEAKER CONTEST: ATTN ALL GRADE LEVELS -For the 83rd consecutive year, the Lions Clubs of California will hold their annual Student Speakers Contest. All grade levels are eligible to participate. Over \$130,500 will be paid out in scholarships to the winning students. Local area winners will win \$100 and can advance to the district level where the winner will be awarded a \$4,500 scholarship and can advance even further in the contest to win up to \$21,000.

This year students will answer the question: "Homelessness in California; What is the Solution?" Please visit the Counseling Dept. Interest forms are due to Mrs. McIntosh in the counseling department by Wednesday, January 22, 2020.
