In order to purchase a Grad Nite ticket you must be clear of any fees or fines from the library or the finance department.

In order to attend Grad Nite you must:

- 1. Have a GPA of 2.0 at the P5 grading period (P5 ends April 17, 2020)
- 2. Have no disciplinary issues
- 3. Must meet 94% attendance on the date of Grad Nite

If the above guidelines are not met, this could result in being ineligible to par ticipate in Grad Nite with no refund.

- ATTENTION SENIORS, JUNIORS, SOPHOMORES and FRESHMEN: If you receive four or more tardies in a week you will receive one lunch detention (per 4 tardies) and a loss of off campus privileges for a week. If you accumulate 10 unexcused tardies and or 10 Unverified/Unexcused Absences then your off campus lunch privilegees will be revoked for the remainder of the grading period. If you have absences for being sick, court, or family emergencies please have your parents call the attendance office. Freshman if you accumulate 10 unexcused tardies you will serve detention to make up missed time during lunch. Please get to class and be on time.
