- AP Students! The deadline to pay for your AP exams is March 5th, 2021. Here are your payment options:
 - Pay \$95 per exam online at the <u>GW Webstore</u> (plus an additional \$4.74 convenience fee). Pay \$95 per exam with either exact cash or a check in person at the GW office (hours 8am-11am or 1-4pm). Please follow safety protocols and wear a mask.

Apply for a Fee waiver based on Family Income (2 Step Process). If you qualify, your exams are FREE! You/your parents must demonstrate financial need by completing the Student Funding Form: https://onlineapps.vusd.org/ submitting a Need Based Application

If you don't qualify for a needs based fee waiver, you may apply for VUSD one-time FREE exam by filling out this request form https://docs.google.com/forms/d/1VU2Hra46JhdMH1MWTcIEhjIP0ODQN-32UNIRega4Vs/edit. This will cover the cost of ONE AP exam. You may only use this once in your high school career. If you have already used this option in a previous year, please do NOT fill out this form.
