FIRST-CLASS FACILITIES

It's rare enough to find the kind of first-class facilities the Academy offers at a graduate-level institution. But to find these kinds of tools and laboratory equipment at an undergrad level is especially unique.

MORE ATTENTION

The student-to-teacher ratio (8:1) is incredibly low. Most classes are held in small, intimate classrooms, ranging in size from 15 to 20 students. Because of this, cadets benefit from the extra attention and access to their instructors—before, during and after class.

TOP TEACHERS

The academic reputation of the Academy attracts the best talent from all over the world. Each faculty member at the Academy must possess a master's degree, and half have obtained a Ph.D.

EXCEPTIONAL LIBERAL ARTS EXPERIENCES

Cadets are trained to be critical thinkers, effective communicators and talented writers—regardless of their major. Plus, the liberal arts program here is tailored toward the role cadets will play as officers in the Air Force.

LEGAL STUDIES MAJOR
