Additional Student Info

- **Tardiness and cutting classes are a serious concern on campus.** Students with FOUR or more tardies in a school week will be subject to lunch detention and revocation of off-campus privileges. If students continue to be habitually tardy to classes and when returning from lunch off-campus, they will be subject to a loss of off-campus privileges for up to an entire marking period. Please do your best to be ON TIME TO EVERY CLASS and engaged in learning the entire period.
- **Effective immediately: Students who do not have an ID card will not be allowed off campus for lunch.** Schedules and ID numbers will no longer be sufficient. If a student has not taken their picture to get an ID or needs a replacement, they may see Mrs. Martinez for a new ID card, which may be subject to a \$5 fee.
