- **Central Valley Scholars presents:** The Thementorship Program was created in light of the disparities in access to undergraduate universities for First Generation, Undocumented, and Black students in the Central Valley. This program was designed with insight from Central Valley students who identified gaps in resources and learning in their own upbringing, pertaining specifically to navigating education, and further progressed based on feedback and learned experiences from our previous two cohorts. Students admitted will receive cohort-based and individual support on their entire college application process, as well as a **\$500 scholarship** and **free laptop** to keep!
