3 Payment Options:

AP Exam Fee: \$97 per exam payable through the <u>GW webstore</u> or through the GW Finance Office.

- 1. **VUSD One-Time FREE AP Exam:** You can only use this once throughout high school and you must submit an application during the registration period. Student must see Ms. Rubio to see if they qualify.
- 2. **College Board Fee Waiver:** You must demonstrate financial need. Your **parents should do this now** so you are verified by the time the registration period opens. Please see Ms. Rubio to see if you qualify for a fee waiver this year. If you qualify for the fee waiver, the price of each exam will be \$15. Questions?
