AP Exam Fee: \$97 per exam payable through the GW webstore or through the GW Finance Office.

- 1. VUSD One-Time FREE AP Exam: You can only use this once throughout high school and you must submit an application during the registration period. Student must see Ms. Rubio to see if they qualify.
- 2. College Board Fee Waiver: You must demonstrate financial need. Your parents **should do this now** so you are verified by the time the registration period opens.
