AP Exam Fee: \$97 per exam payable through the <u>GW webstore</u> or through the GW Finance Office.

1. **VUSD One-Time FREE AP Exam:** You can only use this once throughout high school and you must submit an application during the registration period. Student must see Ms. Rubio to see if they qualify.

2. College Board Fee Waiver: You must demonstrate financial need. Your parents should do this now so you are verified by the time the registration period opens.
