About Kris Belford-Ferguson & Vicki Porter:

Kris Belford-Ferguson was the founding President of the VTEC Scholarship Foundation and the driving force that helped create the Denim & Diamonds fundraiser that allows our foundation to provide scholarships to graduating VTEC seniors pursuing a post-secondary education.

Vicki Porter was the founding principal of VTEC and brought to life her vision of a school where students "learn by doing" and are afforded a head start in their college and career journey. In memory of Kris and in honor of Vicki, this scholarship seeks to recognize one student that demonstrates the character qualities that they both exemplified.



About the Scholarship:

- This award is supplemental to the standard VTEC Scholarships.
- High school seniors entering college and attending accredited U.S. colleges or universities are eligible to apply.
- All funds will be paid directly to the educational institution.

Academic Achievement

Applicants should, upon graduation:

- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- Have a minimum of 12 units completed at College of the Sequoias.
- Demonstrate exceptional speaking and writing skills.

Citizenship, Character and Serious-Mindedness

Strong applicants would:

- Demonstrate a desire to make a meaningful contribution to society, both present & future.
- Demonstrate leadership characteristics and/or assumed leadership positions.
- Pursue goals and aspirations with integrity, resolution, self-discipline, tenacity and judgment.
- Have demonstrated their love of VTEC in service to the school, effectively making VTEC a better place.

Additional Requirements:

- A copy of a completed standard **VTEC Scholarship Application** Form should accompany this Application.
- Two letters of recommendation one from a VTEC instructor and the other from someone unrelated to the applicant who can attest to applicant's character and fortitude.
- Official high school grade transcript <u>and</u> COS transcript.

Application Procedures and deadline:

Applications and attachments must be complete and received no later than **April 15**th by 4:00 p.m in the VTEC office. Applications must be typed or neatly written and in a folder. **Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.**
